SSC MTS Reasoning Tips - Complete Preparation Strategy

In SSC Multi Tasking Staff Examination, the reasoning section carries **25 marks**. Although the reasoning section is time consuming, it is very scoring. Given below is the list of important chapters which are asked in SSC MTS Exam.

How to follow these Reasoning Tips

These reasoning tips aim to help you score maximum possible marks in your SSC MTS exam. Therefore, go through the following strategies to cover various topics and steadily increase your marks! As you follow one step after the other, you will be able to score and more marks. Excited? Good!!! Read on to know more.

1. How to score 10-12 Marks in Reasoning for SSC MTS 2017

To start your preparation for reasoning below is the list topic from which you should start. These topics are being **arranged from the less difficulty level to higher**. So follow the order in which it is mentioned below:

- 1) Classification (3-4 Marks)
- 2) Analogy (3-4 Marks)
- 3) Arranging words in meaningful order (1-2Marks)
- 4) Coding & Decoding (2 Marks)
- 5) Venn diagram (1-2 Marks)
- 6) Word Formation (1-2 Marks)

How to prepare fo these topics:

- **Classification** - Classification questions, require you to find Odd on Out. You have to pick the one option which does not follow the pattern that other options follow. It can be based on numbers, letters, meaningful word. For this you have to simply apply your knowledge of daily life & answer the question. You can practice [Classification Quiz based on Numbers](#) & [Classification Quiz based on Letters](#) to get the idea that in what way questions are actually asked in the exam.

E.g. Pick the Odd one Out: Mango, Banana, Apple, Carrot. Ans - Carrot

- **Analogy** - You have to analyse the relation given in the statement & then find the similar relation between the asked question. You need to draw logical conclusion based on the general topic.

E.g. Eye:Vision :: Ear: ? Ans - Hear

- **Arranging words in Meaningful Order** - If you can arrange words according to the dictionary meaning, you can easily solve these questions. Sometimes you have to arrange different words to form a meaningful sentence.

Eg - *The logical order of the words will be: Root, Stem, Branch, Leaves, Fruit.*

- **Coding Decoding** - Minimum 1Q will always be asked from this topic. Most of the times coding by letter shifting or coding by word is asked. You can learn the [tips of solving the letter shifting problem](#) and [Practice Coding Decoding Quiz](#) & increase your speed.
- **Venn Diagram** - You need to represent the relation between various terms in a venn diagram. [Practice Venn Diagram Quiz](#).

Eg- *Relation between bird, parrot, cat have to be represented in form of venn.*

- **Word Formation** - In these questions high accuracy is possible. The question will have a word from which you will have to check if any of the words given in the options can be formed.

Let us now look at SSC MTS Reasoning Tips to find out how to take your score to 18-20 marks.

2. How to Score 18-20 Marks in Reasoning for SSC MTS 2017

To score further and take your score upto 20 marks, you have to solve the chapters based on following topics:

- 1) Series (2-4 Marks)

2) Direction & Distance (1 Marks)

3) Blood Relation (1-2 Marks)

4) Verbal Reasoning (1 Marks)

5) Puzzles (1-3 Marks)

How to study these chapters:

- **Series** - Questions are based on alphabetical series, number series, completing the given series.
- **Direction & Distance** - From this topic at the most 1 question will be asked. You can practice [Direction & distance questions](#) and get to know the type of questions you will face.
- **Blood Relation** - Questions related to family tree, indicating a person in a photograph, etc. will be asked. You can solve [Blood Relation Quiz](#) to know how to tackle these questions.
- **Verbal Reasoning** - There is a very little chance that verbal reasoning will be asked. But there is no harm for you to study verbal reasoning type questions. Practice problems based on Statements and Conclusions, Statements and Inferences, Statements and Assumptions, Assertion and Reason, etc. Questions on Course of Action, Statements and Arguments can also be asked. In this you have to draw a conclusion by keeping in mind the situation given in question. Practice this [Verbal Reasoning Quiz](#).
- **Puzzles** - Puzzles are easy to solve but take a lot of time. Your knowledge of equation based questions, quant questions (on age, speed and distance) or Seating arrangement will be tested. [Practice Puzzle Quiz here](#).

3. How to Score 23-25 Marks in Reasoning for SSC MTS 2017

You have to cover the whole syllabus thoroughly to score 23 to 25 marks. The topics that can take your score from 18 to 23 can be tricky & confusing. So be prepared to work hard and practice a lot. Here are the topics:

1) Nonverbal Reasoning (4-6 Marks)

2) Matrix (2-3 Marks)

How to prepare these topics:

- **Nonverbal Reasoning** - In this figures based problems are asked such as completing the pattern, Assemble Image, Mirror Image, Hidden Image, Counting Figures. - **Matrix** - For understanding the concept of matrix [practice matrix problem](#) & get to know the way these questions are asked.
